In line with the Council's responsibility to accredit institutions providing education to immigration consultants, it has been determined that the institution known as "CSIC E-Academy" is not regulated by the province in which it is located (New Brunswick) and as such is not eligible for consideration for accreditation. Students that were already enrolled in CSIC E-Academy on July 11, 2011 will be considered to be enrolled in an approved program from which successful graduates will be permitted to write ICCRC's membership exam when it becomes available. Any students enrolling July 12, 2011 or later will not be considered to be enrolled in an approved program.

AUTHORIZED CONTINUING EDUCATION PROVIDERS

The Council will be issuing guidelines shortly to assist members plan their continuing professional development. In general, the Council will accept immigration related programs only, offered by non-profit organizations and schools as well as colleges, including private colleges, which are accredited by and which are licensed to offer programs by provincial educational authorities.
